President of Ricks College, now BYU-Idaho (1930 to 1944), and namesake of the Manwaring Student Center. At the dedication of the Rexburg Idaho temple on February 10, 2008 the following comments were made about Hyrum Manwaring...

President Kinghorn, of the Rexburg temple presidency said when Hyrum Manwaring came to Rexburg in the early 1900's to teach at the Ricks Academy, he wrote in his memoirs that he walked the hill to the

administration building and felt a little depressed and wondered what he was doing in this small, under developed town. He walked further up the hill and looked at the valley and still had feelings of depression. He walked further up the hill so he could overlook the entire valley. He said he felt the Spirit and had a vision opened to his mind that this valley would develop into a modern city and this academy would become a great college. President Kinghorn said he has wondered if President Manwaring was standing on this future temple site when he had this vision. He feels that he was.

Kim Clark, current president of BYU-Idaho spoke and he too mentioned that he feels President Hyrum Manwaring could have been standing on the future site of the Rexburg temple when he had his vision of the valley. He said this spot is a place of revelation.

Albert Manwaring, (Herbert Manwaring's youngest brother) was serving a mission.

The mother's name is Charlotte Bertha Sperry, and her daughter's names are:

Bessie Estella Manwaring (farthest to the right) 9 years of age; She married a man by the name of Brockbank. She since has died. I did go over to Springville a few years ago to meet her. She was 100 years old then. She had lost her eyesight but was still living alone. Then, she went to California to live with her son and that's where she died. The little girl next to her is Ora Manwaring who married a man by the name of Gardner. She was 7 at the time of the picture. Her daughter, Marietta Gardner was at Logan when I attended there. We met and found out we were related. Since then, we have corresponded over the years. She and her husband came to see me about 2 1/2 months ago. They live in Salt Lake. Her husband, Ray Forman is related to Marvin Wray. The third little girl is Arvilla Manwaring, age 5. I don't know anything about her.
